

VPN Connects fine but cannot ping

On the remote PC's;

START > Control Panel > Windows Firewall > Advanced TAB > ICMP > Check 'Allow incoming echo request' > OK

This will allow your computers to respond to a ping, to allow the shares to be seen;

START > Control Panel > Windows Firewall > Exceptions TAB > Double click 'File and Printer Sharing' > Double click 'TCP 445' > Select 'Any computer (including those on the internet)'

If your a little more security concious, you can select 'Custom List', then add the following line;

192.168.0.0/255.255.255.0,192.168.2.0/255.255.255.0

This would only allow both your subnets (just incase something ever did penetrate the firewall)
