

Mac OS X 10.5, PS121v2, and Hewlett Packard printers

It is possible to print wirelessly to HP printers but there are several steps involved.

First of all, don't even think about using HP printer drivers, which only work via direct USB connection. OS 10.5 comes with a set of drivers called "Gutenprint" that work around this issue; however, not all HP printers are supported by these drivers. Here's what to do if your printer is not on the list.

First, you have to go to this website:

and download three files:

- Foomatic RIP
- Ghostscript for Mac OS 10.5
- HPIJS for mac os 10.5

I would install them in this order. Once this is done:

1. Pull up System Preferences, click on Print and Fax.
2. This brings up a window that, among other things, has a column labeled 'Printers' on the left. Below are two buttons, click on the +.
3. This brings up another window. Along the top is a row of icons, click on the one that says "IP."
4. For Protocol, choose HP direct - socket.
5. Under address, enter the IP address of the print server you got when you set it up.
6. Queue is left blank.
7. You can name it anything you want.
8. Under "Print using:" choose "Select a driver to use." You should be able to find your HP model with the term "Foomatic - recommended" next to it. Click on that, and you should be good to go.
