

First, disable the affected VPN Policy on the firewall (important) and access the firewall CLI via Telnet.

List your IKE Policies with the following command:

```
/vpn/policies/ikePolicies/getAll
```

You need to look at the list to figure out which policy ID has the IKE key you need to change. (It's the first number on the line after "<modeCfgRecId>".) Once you have the the correct policy ID number, you can change the IKE shared key with the following command:

```
/vpn/policies/ikePolicies/edit policyID [ENTER POLICY ID HERE] authString [ENTER NEW IKE KEY HERE]
```

You can check to make sure the change was made by running the following command:

```
/vpn/policies/ikePolicies/get policyID [ENTER POLICY ID HERE]
```
