

## **How to uninstall all the installation files/ drivers after "add/remove program" did uninstall correctly.**

You will need A copy of Revo uninstaller (<http://www.revouninstaller.com>)

1.- Install Revo software

2.- run Revo and uninstall application - use complete uninstall (bottom options) -

\*\* for network adapters ,this may leave the drivers in place, may only uninstall the utility. if you are working with network adapters, follow #4~8

3.- reboot your computer.

4.- Go to Control Panel -> Administrative Tools -> Services -> and find the service "Wireless zero configuration" down the bottom of the list. Right click on it and -> properties -> make it start "Automatically" -> Start it (before you leave the window)

5.- Go to network connections and right click on "Wireless Connection....."

6.- Click on properties

7.- Click on Wireless Network

8.- Select your SSID from inside the box and click on properties.

Add you password and encryption type.

OK the changes.

You are done.

Note: Other alternative uninstaller that may also work is CCleaner (<http://www.ccleaner.com/>)
